



2023 SDO BENGUET TEACHERS' DAY AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (IP) SPORTS COMPETITION

- 1. In connection with the celebration of the Benguet Teachers' Day on September 29, 2023, there will be a Teachers' Day and Indigenous Peoples (IP) Sports Competition in the following sports events:
 - a) Volleyball- Men & Women
 - b) Basketball-Men and 3 X 3 Basketball-Men
 - c) Chess- Men & Women
 - d) Darts- Men & Women
 - e) Table Tennis- Men & Women,
 - f) Billiards- Men & Women,
 - g) Arnis- Men & Women
 - h) Futsal-women
 - i) Slow Pitch- Men & Women
 - i) Badminton Men & Women
 - k) IPED Games (Kadangkadang- Men & Women, Salikawkaw-Women, Tug-of-war Men & Women and Arm Wrestling (Sanggol) Men & Women.
- 2. Participants in this sports competition are DepEd, Teaching and Non-Teaching Elementary and Secondary staff including the SDO personnel. Regular, LGU, PTA-paid, Casual, Job order, and Substitute Teachers are all eligible to participate.
- 3. The composition of teams is as follows
 - a) 1 Team per district- Elementary, and Secondary combined in all the above sports competitions except the Districts of La Trinidad and Itogon I and II combined, where the elementary and secondary personnel shall be composed of separate teams



b) Division Office Personnel

c) BSU Elementary and Secondary personnel Note: Private schools are encouraged to join in their respective districts. Each team shall designate a playing coach.

- 4. Rules of the games shall adopt the DepEd-sanctioned updated rules, including the standard number of players per team (RA 10588, see enclosure 1). The tournament format e.g., round robin, double elimination, etc. shall be decided by the tournament managers depending on the number of teams submitted.
- 5. The simple Opening Program shall be on September 16, 2023 (Saturday), at 8:00 AM at the Benguet National High School. Games will immediately commence. Succeeding games shall be every Saturday and Sunday upon agreement of the concerned teams. It is expected that the Teacher's sports competition will culminate on October 7, 2023. This will be at the same time as the opening of the IPED celebration. IP games with IP attire will be played on the same date. A separate memo shall be issued regarding the IPED Month Celebration.
- 6. Teams must accomplish a **Gallery of Players** in all the above events indicating the name, age, and school. Computer-generated photo is accepted (see enclosure 1).
- 7. Proper sports attire must be worn during the games. Playing attires must bear numbers for easy identification, especially in team games.
- 8. **Certificates of Recognition** shall be awarded to First, Second, and Third placers, while Certificates of Participation shall be awarded to fourth placers and below.
- 9. Technical Officials shall come from DepEd personnel and or volunteers. There are no honoraria to be given to the management and technical officials (see list of technical officials to be issued later).
- 10. Interested participants are requested to confirm their participation on or before September 13, 2023, to Mr. Ceasar B. Luma-ang, Division Sports Officer through his mobile number at 09283188179 or through his Facebook messenger.
- 11. Each event shall designate a secretariat to take charge of paperwork i.e., production of score sheets and printing of certificates. Certificate papers shall be provided by the Division Office through the School Governance and Operations Division- School Mobilization and Networking (SMN).














- 12. Meals and snacks, fare/fuel, and other incidental expenses in connection with this DepEd Teachers Day Sports shall be from local and or personal funds.
