


1. Relative to the conduct of the 2019 Division Festival of Talents slated on October 29-31 2019 at the Tublay School of Home Industries (TSHI), Acop, Tublay, Benguet, this office hereby issues these additional details for the guidance of all participating schools, to wit:

- a. Arrival and registration of participants shall start at 1:00 P.M. on October 28, 2019 and the solidarity meeting will be at 3:00 P.M at TSHI open gym. The parade will start at 7:00 A.M. at the TSHI Quadrangle followed by the opening program at 9:00 o'clock on October 29, 2019. The awarding and closing program will be on the afternoon of October 30, 2019.
- b. The registration fee of P800.00 per participant shall be collected to cover expenses for catered meals and snacks for three days, honoraria of judges and other incidental expenses, chargeable against local fund/school MOOE subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations shall be collected upon registration. - c. Submission for best Strategic Intervention Materials (SIM) and one best research proposal in EPP/TLE for elementary and one for the secondary teachers will be submitted on October 21 instead of October 17, 2019.
