## 2018 METROBANK-MTAP DEPED MATH CHALLENGE

To:

Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary and Secondary School Heads (Private & Public) Teachers

- 1. The Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), the Mathematics Teachers of the Philippines (MTAP) and the Department of Education (DepEd) announce the holding of the 2018 Metrobank-MTAP-DepED Math challenge from January to March 2018.
- 2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute in improving the quality of Mathematics education in the Philippines. Specially, it aims to:
  - a. awaken greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and high school students in both public and private schools all over the country;
  - b. encourage students to strive for excellence for Mathematics;
  - c. Encourage mastery of basic Mathematics skills;
  - d. Discover mathematical talents among the students;
  - e. Develop the values hardwork, perseverance, honesty, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and
  - f. Provide students with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
- 3. The elimination and district/division level competition will be participated in by all elementary school pupils (Private & Public) on January 12, 20118 at their respected district (Please coordinate to your district Math Coordinator).



4. All secondary students (Private and Public) will participate in the division level competition in two different clusters and dates:

- 5. Three students per grade/year level shall represent each school, for both public and private, in the elimination round.
- 6. The contest mechanics/guidelines of the competition are contained in the enclosures.
- 7. Result of the elimination round per district will be submitted on or before January 22, 2018.
- 8. Registration fee of Twenty Five (PHP20.00) per participants will be collected to defray expenses for meals & snacks of proctors, certificates and other expenses.
- Travel expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds or PTA funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
