

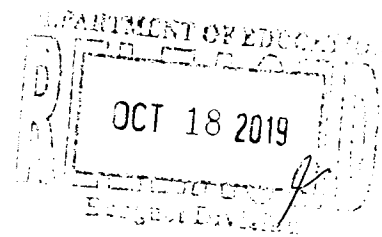


SUBJECT: 2019 DIVISION READ-A-THON

Date: November 13, 2019

- Participants to this activity are five (5) grade III and five (5) grade V pupils in the Elementary who were declared winners in the district Read-a-thon level contest.
- Grade III pupils will be reading in Filipino while Grade V pupils will be for English.
- Meals / snacks as well as travel expenses and other expenses of participants relative to their participation to the activity shall be charged against local funds or PTA funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS IN THE 2017 DIVISION READ-A-THON CONTEST

1. The Read-A-Thon contest has the following categories: Best Team Readers (Quiz Bee), Best Story Retelling, and Best in Oral Reading Interpretation. This contest will be in Filipino for Grade III pupils and in English for Grade V pupils. The district Read-A-Thon should be able to select the best team who will compete at the division level.

2. BEST TEAM READERS CONTEST

1. The team is composed of three (3) pupils in Grade III ,three (3) pupils in Grade V who were declared winners in the district level contest.
2. Each team will be given a set of five story copies written in Filipino/English. Comprehension and vocabulary questions will be taken from these stories.
3. The team will be given one hour to read the stories. Coaches will not be allowed to interact with their team during the reading time.
4. A quiz master will ask three (3) rounds of 6 questions on comprehension and vocabulary questions per round about the prescribed story with the following categorization: Easy, Average, and Difficult
5. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared first, second and third placers.
6. In case of a tie, clincher questions will be asked.

3. BEST IN ORAL READING INTERPRETATION

1. The contestants will be asked to read aloud a story identified by the judges. The story is taken from the five (5) stories used by the team readers. They will be judged accordingly to their ability to read orally with accuracy and fluency, correct oral interpretation, voice projection, audience impact and the level of confidence.
2. There will be one (1) participant per medium and per district.
3. The contestants shall read orally the same story identified by the judges, one at a time.
4. The contestants shall be ranked and the top three (3) winners shall be determined.
5. The winners will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the criteria below.

Audience Impact	10%

4. BEST IN RETELLING

1. The contestants will be asked to retell a story identified by the judges. The story is taken from the five (5) stories used by the team readers. They will be judged according to their ability to retell orally with accuracy and fluency, correct oral interpretation, voice projection, audience impact and the level of confidence.
2. There will be one (1) participant per medium and per district.
3. The contestants shall retell orally the story identified by the judges, one at a time.
4. The contestants shall be ranked and the top three (3) winners shall be determined.
5. The winners will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the criteria below.
