

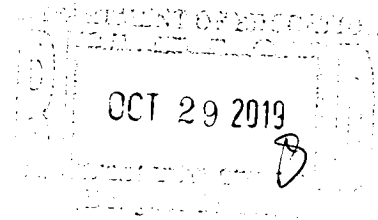

SUBJECT: **YOUTH ADVOCATES ON ADOLESCENT SEXUALITY, REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND GENDER RESPONSIVENESS CAMP**

DATE: 28 October 2019

1. In celebration of the National Children's Month in November, the Schools Division of Benguet in partnership with the Child and Family Services Philippines, Inc. (CFSPI) shall conduct a **YOUTH ADVOCATES ON ADOLESCENT SEXUALITY, REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND GENDER RESPONSIVENESS CAMP** with the theme, "*Napipinget ay Nangibaag Sin Gawis ay Kapadaan*" (Young Core Advocates of Good Experience) on **November 4-6, 2019** at **CFSPI Homes, 11 Manzanillo Subdivision, Easter Road, Baguio City**.
2. The youth camp aims to:
 - a. create mechanisms for safe and child friendly schools and communities, sustaining the values and potentials of young leaders through developing champions in the integration of proper information on Adolescent Reproductive Health, Child Protection and other related issues.
 - b. enhance awareness of children and youth on the significant relationships of adolescents, sexuality, reproductive health and child protection.
 - c. develop and motivating young leaders to be the core advocates on the prevention of abuse among children and protecting their right including the right to be informed on the Adolescent Sexuality and Reproductive Health.
3. The participants are expected to check-in on Day 1- November 4, 2019 before 8 am. First meal to be served is AM Snacks and the last meal to be served is PM Snacks on the last day of the camp.
4. Participants to the said activity are Grade 9 Students and accompanying Teacher-Adviser represented by 14 Districts. *See attached file for the list of participants.*

5. Also, participants are to bring their own toiletries and towels. They are also requested to bring their Benguet attire for the Cultural Night on the first day.
6. Meals, snacks and accommodation shall be covered by the CFSPi Consuelo Zobel Alger Foundation while travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to School MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
