- Two lunch meals and four snacks of high school student participants will be charged to the Schools Division Office (SDO) MOOE while that of the elementary pupil participants will be charged to the Special Education Fund (SEF) of the Benguet Provincial Government. Transportation and other incidental expenses of student participants and their coaches shall be charged against local/school/journalism fund subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
- The list of facilitators to assist the resource persons are found in the enclosure.
- Considering the schedule of the RSPC which entails the start of travel in the early morning or evening of November 25 depending on the availability of transportation, participants coming from far flung areas may bring with them their sufficient clothing and other personal effects for the whole duration of the cliniquing and the RSPC.
- All student participants are also required to bring with them their Parent's Consent and official school identification card.
- There will be a special meeting of all concerned coaches/school paper advisers on November 23, 2019, 9:00 o'clock in the morning at the La Trinidad Central School Open gym while the cliniquing sessions are ongoing.
