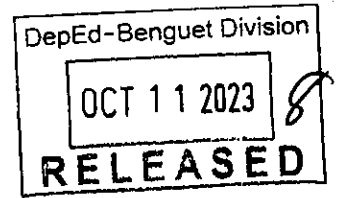

2023 DIVISION CONTEST/SHOWCASING OF TALENTS IN EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO (EsP) in CELEBRATION OF THE FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

1. Pursuant to the MATATAG AGENDA particularly on **Take good care of learners** and as part of the celebration of the Filipino Values Month every November of every year as per Presidential Proclamation No. 479 s. 1994, a Division Contest/Showcasing of Talents in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (**EsP**) will be conducted by the Schools Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division on November 24-25, 2023. The theme for last year's celebration "**Magagandang Kaugaliang Filipino: Isabuhay at Payamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan,**" will still be used in this contest.
2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. advocate and strengthen the practice of the Filipino values;
 - b. provide male and female learner-participants with equal opportunities to discover, develop and display their talents and skills, and
 - c. increase collaboration between and among teachers, parents and guardians.
3. All elementary and secondary schools shall conduct school level activities in celebration of the Filipino Values Month this November, which may include integrating the theme into class discussions and learning activities, showcasing of talents, creating and posting campaign posters and other related advocacy materials and conduct of contests stipulated in the enclosure.
4. The events to be contested in the elementary and secondary level are the following: Story Telling, Solo Singing, Interpretative Dance and Composition Writing except for Story Telling which is for the elementary level only.
5. First placers in the school shall participate in the district level activities. Similarly, the first-place winners in the events for the different key stages in the district shall qualify for the division level contests. Each district shall have ten (10)

participants in the elementary level distributed in the four contest events in the two key stages: Keys stage 1 and Key Stage 2. For the secondary level, each district shall have eight (8) participants distributed in the three (3) events in Key stages 3 and 4. The summary of district entries is in **enclosure 1**.

6. The general contest guidelines/mechanics are found in **enclosure 2**.
7. Timeline of Activities is presented in **Enclosure 3** for guidance.
8. The Technical Working Group (TWG) for the activity are listed in **enclosure 4**. They shall be granted one day COC/CTO or service credits subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations.
9. Meals and snacks of the participants for the activities shall be charged against the 2023 Provincial Special Education Fund while travel and incidental expenses shall be charged against available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CRITERIA/ MECHANICS OF CONTEST ACTIVITIES

1. Mechanics

- a. Contestants are currently enrolled in public schools for SY 2023 – 2024.
- b. Contestant is allowed to participate in **ONE** category only.
- c. Contestant is given freedom to choose his/her own piece for **Story Telling in Filipino** aligned with the theme with the help of parent/guardian/ teacher. A time limit of three (3) to five (5) minutes will be allotted for the actual storytelling.
- d. The contest piece for **Solo Singing** for the elementary is “Dakilang Lahi” by Charice Pempengco and for the secondary “Bagani: Ating Lahi” both songs with Karaoke background.
- e. For the **Interpretative Dance** contest, there will be two participants for each key stage. “Ako ay Pilipino” by Kuh Ledesma will be the music for elementary and “Magsimula Ka” by Leo Valdez for the secondary. Both are to be recorded through “Tiktok” in a normal speed. The time limit of three (3) to five (5) minutes performance shall be observed.
- f. For **Composition Writing**, the contestant is to write his/her understanding/ experience in relation with the theme. Either Filipino or Mother Tongue will be used for key stage 1 but solely Filipino for key stages 2-4. Key stage 1 contestants should have 400-500 -word composition on their corresponding grade pad paper. For key stages 2-4, their essay will be encoded double space in an A4 size bond paper using Bookman Old Style, font 11, and one (1) inch margin on all the four sides of the paper will be observed. The number of words in the composition will be as follows; Key stage 2-1 000 words, Key stage 3-1 500 words and Key stage 4 -2 000 words.
- h. The entries shall be submitted through video, with maximum resolution of 720 p (16:9) to optimal 1080p (16:9) and maybe saved in .vmw, .mov, .mp4, or .mpg file formats except for the composition writing where the hard copies of the qualified entries will be submitted.
- i. All entries must be submitted online through the link tinyurl.com/4ayt9zme or onsite at the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) section at the division office on or before **November 22, 2023**, until 5 o'clock in the afternoon. Late submission of entries will not be considered.
- i. Mechanics/criteria in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
- j. Winners per category will be identified by the Board of Judges and the decision of the board of judges is final.
- k. First to third placers learner-winners will receive cash incentives from the
