
2021 BENGUET TEACHERS' MONTH CELEBRATION AND SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

- 1. Presidential Proclamation No. 242, declared September 5 to October 5 of every year as "National Teachers' Month" and in recognition of the teachers and the central role they play in guiding children, youth and adults through the life-long process, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Benguet amended Provincial Ordinance No. 20-266 with the title "An ordinance amending Provincial Ordinance No. 15-170, entitled "Declaring the last Friday of September of each year as Official Teachers' Day in the Province of Benguet and appropriating funds therefor".
- 2. Resolved during the Benguet Teachers' Day Council Meeting on September 3, 2021 and transcribed in Executive Order no. 2021-023, occurrences and or prefatory activities for the Benguet Teachers' Month with the theme "Gurong Filipino, Katuwang sa Hamon, Kasama sa Pagbangon!" in partnership with the Provincial Government of Benguet shall commence upon the release of this memorandum through to the culminating program on November 19, 2021. The conformity facilitates adequate preparations for the events. As such, the Schools Division of Benguet releases these guidelines with the following activity schedules to wit:

The conduct of the Benguet Teachers Month activities shall strictly adhere to the prescribed health standards consistent with the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF) health protocols, Department of Health (DOH) Health Standards, National and Local quarantine rules and other relevant protocols as detailed in DepEd and DepEd Task Force COVID-19 issuances.

Funds for the culminating activity to cover lunch, AM and PM snacks shall be charged to the General Fund under the Provincial Governor's Office while expenses incurred by the participants relative to the activities under this memorandum shall be charged to local funds subject to the accounting rules and regulations
- 6. Immediate dissemination to all concerned is desired.

Criteria for Judging

INDICATOR	DESCRIPTION	SCORE (%)
Overall Performance	A judgement on the contestant's ability to present original material that draws a positive response from the audience with personality, originality and poise.	30
Audience Response	This judgment is not based solely on the final applause after the performance, rather, it is judged based on the ability of the contestant to draw the audience into the performance, eliciting a positive response.	10
Stage Appearance and Presence	A judgement on the performer(s) attitude, including their personality originality, confidence, their eye contact with the audience and professionalism (their reaction to mistakes, giggling during the performance, etc.) Also, a judgement on their overall appearance display.	10
Originality	The performer(s) ability to create a piece of work that is distinctive or different from the other performers. It creates creativity, ingenuity, confidence and personality to present an original peace.	15
Personality	A judgement on whether or not the performer(s) personality is displayed throughout the performance	10
Creativity, Coordination, Organization	A judgement based on the creativity of the performer(s). Ex: Did the performers have creative dance moves or were creative signs added to the performance? A judgement on purely the organization of the performance. Ex: Was the spacing off in the performance or were words forgotten in the performance, or were dancers coordinated?	25
