

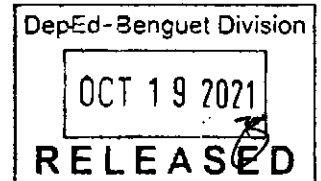

**Participation of DepEd in the 2021 Community-Based Immunization**

1. Due to the suspension of face-to-face classes the annual implementation of the School-Based Immunization will be shifted to Community-Based Immunization (CBI) which shall be led by the DOH in partnership with the local government units (LGUs).
2. In this regard, the Department of Education under the OUA MEMO 00-0921-0236 request that participation and support of all personnel concerned in the school's division office, elementary and junior high schools.
3. The SDO School Health Section and field nurses shall participate in CBI-related activities of the DOH (e.g., virtual coordination, consultative meetings, orientations, awareness campaigns, etc.); and conduct of health promotion advocacies for teachers, parents and learners through appropriate platforms.
4. The DepEd nurses in the field shall prepare and consolidate the needed Master List of Learners (Grade 1, Grade 4, & Grade 7) for SY2020-2021 (see Annex A, B, & C) and endorse to their respective counterpart LGUs.
5. The participation of DepEd field nurses in the vaccination activity is voluntary but is highly encouraged. Their volunteering days in the CBI shall be counted as working days. This is for them to meet the required number of days to be entitled to hazard pay benefit.
6. Upon participation, the DepEd nurse shall only be assigned under the Fixed Site Administration approach and are expected to strictly follow minimum public health standards. The DOH shall provide them necessary personal protective equipment (PPE), alcohol, sanitizers, and other disinfectants to ensure their safety.

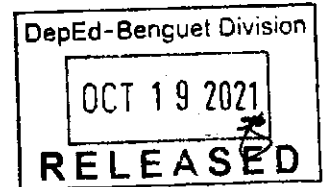
