



### Campus Journalism Virtual Enhancement for Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) conducted the 2021 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) from August 11 to 13, 2021 online, dubbed as the National Conference on Campus Journalism in the 21st Century with the theme, **Pahayagang Pangkampus: Kaagapay sa Paghilom at Pagbangon ng Sambayanan**. This is pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (1RR) specifically Rule IX of Section 1.
- 2. The Division of Benguet identified school paper advisers and student Journalists from the elementary and secondary level to attend to this endeavor. The 2021 National Schools Press Conference was not a competition in writing journalistic news rather it was made an avenue for the participants to enhance their knowledge and skills on campus journalism by listening to lectures from popular journalists in metro manila. The topics include News and Feature Writing, Editorial and Column Writing, Photojournalism and Online Publication, Development of Instructional Materials in Campus Journalism, Search for Outstanding Campus Journalism Project, Research in Campus Journalism and many more.
- 3. Relative to this, the English department will be conducting a Campus Journalism Virtual Enhancement for Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers on November 24,25, and 26, 2021


