

INSTITUTIONALIZING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11285 OR THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION ACT

- 1. Republic Act No. 11285 or the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act (EE&C) institutionalizes energy efficiency and conservation, enhances the efficient use of energy, and grants incentives to energy efficiency and conservation programs and projects. directing all government entities to implement the EE&C Act.
- 2. To provide direction on the implementation of the Government Energy Management Program (GEMP), the Inter-Agency Energy Efficiency and Conservation Committee (IAEECC) issued the following advisory and resolutions:
 - Advisory No. 1 Enjoining All Concerned in the Government to Realize at least Ten Percent (10%) Cost Savings;
 - Resolution No. 1, s. 2020 Directing All Government Agencies, Including the Local Government Units (LGUs) and Foreign Service Posts, to Comply with the GEMP, Ordering the DOE to Conduct Energy Audits and Spot Checks, and Submit Proposed Improvements to the GEMP;
 - Resolution No. 2, s. 2021 Directing All Government Entities, Including the LGUs and Foreign Service Posts, to Use Energy Efficient Light Emitting Diode (LED) Lamps in Government Buildings and Facilities as a Requirement for Compliance to the GEMP; and,
 - Resolution No. 3, s. 2021 Directing All Government Entities, including the LGUs and Foreign Service Posts, to Use Inverter Type Air-Conditioning Units in Government Buildings and Facilities as a Requirement for Compliance to the GEMP.
- 3. In this light, we would like to remind all schools and offices under the ambit of this office on the implementation of GEMP and the compliance to the said advisory and resolutions. All personnel are also enjoined to observe efficiency in the conservation of

energy, fuel, water, etc. Likewise please be reminded to comply with the following reportorial requirements prescribed by the GEMP:

- Designation of Energy Efficiency and Conservation Officer (EECO)
- Designation of Energy Efficiency and Conservation Focal Person (EECF)
- Monthly Electricity Consumption Report (MECR)
- Monthly Fuel Consumption Report (MFCR)
- 4. The required reports shall be submitted monthly to this office, care of the designated Division Energy Efficiency and Conservation Officer, Glenn N. Duguis, Administrative Officer V or through his email, glenn.duguis@deped.gov.ph
- 5. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
