REGIONAL MASS TRAINING OF GRADE 10 TEACHERS

To: Education Program Supervisors Secondary School Heads Secondary Teachers (Grade 10)

1. To ensure effective implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education, through the Regional and Schools Division Office, will conduct the Regional Mass Training of Grade 10 Teachers on the following dates and venues:

University of Baguio	English, Araling Panlipunan (AP) and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP)	May 24 – 29, 2015
University of the Cordilleras	Filipino and MAPEH	May 17 – 22, 2015
Saint Louis University	Science and Mathematics	May 24 – 29, 2015

- 2. The training aims to enable Grade 10 teachers to:
 - a. Deepen appreciation of the K to 12 coded curriculum through the use of the curriculum guides, teaching guides and learning materials;
 - b. Demonstrate understanding of the issues/concerns relative to content, performance standards, assessment and rating system;
 - c. Identify appropriate pedagogies especially in localizing and indigenizing the curriculum; and
 - d. Cite concrete measures to assist all types of students.
- 3. This is a live-in training and all participants are expected to be at the venue in the morning of the first day (Sunday) for registration and the opening program/orientation. Further, participants are advised to **bring DepEd ID** for verification purposes. Attached are the lists of participants by school and subject areas.
- 4. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to their respective local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Service credit/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) shall be given to participants/facilitators, whichever is applicable.
