1. Relative to the conduct of the REGIONAL CONTESTS IN SOLIDARITY WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE 28th COMMEMORATION OF THE CORDILLERA MONTH ON JULY 2015, a division level contest or search will be conducted on June 22, 2015 at the Division Office Adivay Hall for the following categories;
 - a. Best Cordillera Hymn/March in Action
 - b. Best K to 12 Jingle
2. The guidelines for the search shall follow the guideline provided for the regional search/contests. See enclosure attached.
3. District offices shall conduct this search within their Districts to come up with their entries to the Division level search/contest. The first place winners are the District entries to the Division level contest. The winning piece in each contest shall be submitted in CD labeled and attached with the list of contestants. All entries shall be transmitted to the Division Office on or before 5:00 O'clock in the afternoon of June 22, 2015 through the records section. Late submission will not be judged.
4. Division judging shall be done on June 23/ 24, 2015 and the first place winners will serve as the Division entry to the region to be submitted in the morning of June 26, 2015.
5. The top 3 winners in the Division level will be awarded certificates of recognition for both the coaches/trainers and contestants.
6. Cash prizes will be awarded to the winning entries in the regional level in each contests;

First Prize – P10,000.00
Second Prize – 7,000.00
Third Place - 5,000.00
All other entries shall be awarded a participation prize of P3,000.00.
7. The winning entries in the regional level shall become advocacy material for the whole region for a one cordillera and K to 12.

**REGIONAL CONTESTS IN SOLIDARITY WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE
28th COMMEMORATION OF THE CORDILLERA MONTH ON JULY 2015**

General Guidelines:

1. The presentation should also portray a cordillera touch or accent. The jingle maybe in English, Filipino, Ilocano or a combination thereof.

Specific Guidelines:

a. Search for the Best Cordillera Hymn in Action

1. The presentation must be simple and easy but elegant/majestic;
2. The participants shall compose a maximum of 12 (4 elementary pupils, 4 high school pupils, and 4 teachers and personnel);
3. The contestants shall sing the Cordillera Hymn with actions while marching in place(stationary);
4. The action shall be simple and easy to follow; and
5. The winning piece shall be submitted in CD(video editing is allowed).
6. The criteria for judging are:

<i>Musicality/Blending</i>	-	35%
<i>Creativity</i>	-	20%
<i>Turning and Coordination</i>	-	35%
<i>Projection and Style</i>	-	10%
<i>Total</i>	-	100%

b. K to 12 Advocacy Jingle particularly Senior High School

1. The contest piece shall portray the different tracks of Senior high School;
2. The participants shall compose a maximum of 16 (elementary pupils, high school students and teachers and personnel);
3. The presentation shall convey the public about the K to 12;
4. The presentation should be made within a maximum of 4 minutes;
5. The winning piece shall be submitted in CD,(video editing is allowed);
6. The criteria for judging are:

<i>Musicality</i>	-	25%
<i>Creativity and Originality</i>	-	10%
<i>Choreography</i>	-	15%
<i>Viewer's Impact</i>	-	20%
<i>Interpretation of the Theme</i>	-	30%
<i>Total</i>	-	100%
