



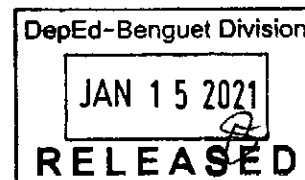

**ANNUAL MEDICAL, DENTAL AND LABORATORY EXAMINATION FOR BENGUET
DIVISION CY 2020**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 22 s. 2015 entitled Annual Physical Examination of DepEd employees (Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel), as a manifestation of concern of Benguet Division on the health status of its employees, all teaching and teaching are required to undergo Annual Physical Examination (APE) including Dental Examination in compliance with the Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 17 s. 1989.
2. The activity aims to Determine the presence of communicable, non-communicable and dental illnesses among Benguet Division personnel, Increase awareness on the risk factors for non-communicable diseases and Provide medical/dental intervention and flu vaccination as preventive and curative measures to ailments.
3. The following provisions, Deped Orders and Memorandums shall be observed in the implementation of the Annual Physical Examination of Teaching and Non-teaching personnel
 - ✓ TSEKAP Service Provider (Tamang Serbisyo para sa Kalusugan ng Pamilya)
 - ✓ (DO 28 S. 2020 - Guidelines on the Grant of Five Hundred Pesos Financial Assistance
4. Chest X –RAY is required to all employees except for those Pregnant women in their 1st and 2nd trimester of pregnancy who are instead advised to undergo sputum microscopy. Personnel with Chest X-RAY taken 6 months earlier should undergo same procedure. (DO No. 44 s. 2004 Strengthening TB Prevention and Control Program
5. **Benguet Division Teaching and Non-teaching personnel with no Form 86 from January 2020 to December 2020 shall comply with the Routine Laboratory Test (Urinalysis, Complete Blood Count and Chest X-RAY) and submit duly signed Form 86 to the School and District Nurses for Health recording, Health evaluation and monitoring purposes until the 1st quarter of the calendar year 2021.**
6. IATF minimum health protocol shall be strictly observed and immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum to all concerned is desired.


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
