



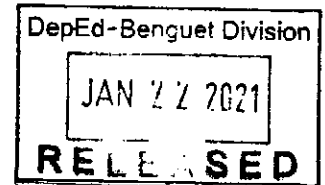



Fourth Division Storybook Writing Contest for K to 6 Teacher and First Division Illustration Contest for K to 12 Teachers

1. As part of our SINTIL (Serving Immeasurably to Nurture I-Benguet Learners), the Schools Division Office through the CID-LRMS shall conduct the **Fourth Division Storybook Writing Contest for K to 6 Teacher and First Division Illustration Contest for K to 12 Teachers**.
2. The main objective of the contests is to gather more locally developed and contextualized stories to be used in the schools.
3. The Fourth Division Storybook Writing Contest for K to 6 teachers will start on January 25, 2021 while the First Division Illustration Contest for K to 12 Teachers will start on May 3, 2021.
4. Please refer to Annexes A, B and C for the Mechanics of the contests, the Timetable and the rubrics for judging, respectively.

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Annex A: Contest Mechanics/Guidelines

A. Storybook Writing Contest for K to 6 Teachers

1. Any teacher from Kindergarten to Grade VI can join the contest. The contestant can choose one of the major languages used in Benguet including English and Filipino.
2. The contestant shall write the manuscript of his/her original story on A4 bond paper, landscape alongside with his/her suggested illustration following the format below:

Suggested Illustration	Manuscript
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3. For K to Grade 1, follow picture-text format with maximum pages of 16, for grade 2 to 3, picture-text-text format with maximum pages of 24, for grade 4 to 6, may follow picture-text-text format with maximum pages of 32.
4. The Public Schools District Supervisor or District In-charge shall form a panel of judges of not less than three to evaluate the stories.
5. The panel of judges in the District Level shall recommend one best story as entry to the Division Level.
6. All stories submitted to the District Level for the said contest shall be submitted to the CID-LRMS. These shall be considered SDO-Benguet owned.
7. The Schools Division Office through the CID-LRMS shall likewise form a panel of judges to evaluate the best stories recommended by the districts.
8. There shall be three best stories (in any language) to be chosen.
9. Certificates and tokens shall be given to the best storybook writers.





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B. Illustration Contest for K to 12 Teachers

1. Any teacher from Kindergarten to Grade 12 can join the Illustration contest.
2. Each contestant shall be given a copy of the manuscript of the best storybooks.
3. Each contestant shall illustrate the story as suggested by the writer or as agreed by the writer and the illustrator.
4. The contestants shall submit their output directly to the CID-LRMS for evaluation. Likewise, these shall be considered SDO-Benguet owned.
5. The CID-LRMS shall form a committee of not less than three to evaluate/ judge the outputs of the contestants. There shall be three winners.
6. Certificates and tokens shall be given to the best illustrators.



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
