

SDO BENGUET 2021 WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

- The Schools Division of Benguet announces the celebration of 2021 National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) pursuant to the Proclamation No. 224, s. 1988: Declaring the First Week of March of Every Year as Women's Week and March 8, 1988 and Every Year Thereafter as Women's Rights and International Peace Day.
- The NWMC focuses on strengthening efforts to improve and track the progress of the implementation of the Magna Carta of Women (MCW), and other relevant laws and commitments to the international community such as the Convention on the Elimination of All forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW), the Beijing Platform for Action (BPfA), and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 3. This annual celebration shall provide an avenue to discuss and address the issues women continue to face thus, empowerment can be fully achieved. Finally, this campaign is also a call for concrete, sustainable and inclusive actions towards gender equality.

 - inform and engage women as stakeholders of government programs and services to promote citizen-centric governance and make "change" a conscious effort to know, understand, and provide programs based on needs.
 - create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD) – to strengthen implementation of the Magna Carta of Women; and
 - inspire and empower women and girls to be agents of change to contribute in promoting gender equality and the empowerment of all women.
