

1st BIKE FOR HOPE: 2nd Ambuklao Mountain Bike Challenge

In support to "Project Salaknib tan Namnama"

- 1. In support of the Salaknib tan Namnama Project of the DepEd Regional Office, the Schools Division of Benguet is organizing the 1st BIKE FOR HOPE: 2nd Ambuklao Mountain Bike Challenge on May 8, 2021 in Itogon, Benguet. This initiative aims to raise fund intended for learners in marginalized, hard-to-reach, and vulnerable situations in Benguet. Furthermore, it is also SDO Benguet's contribution to promoting healthy living and strengthening camaraderie through biking as well as sustaining healthy interaction between and among the student/ pupil learners, teachers and school heads, parents, community members and other stakeholders for the enrichment of quality basic education programs and initiatives.
- 2. In previous years we have shown our kindness and generosity particularly to learners and other basic education stakeholders not only in the province but also in other regions and provinces who were affected by various calamities and disasters. In 2017, we were able to generate an amount of 337,000.00 for the donation drive done for Marawi. In 2018 we called for voluntary cash donations for students and personnel of DepEd Benguet who were affected by Typhoon Ompong in which we were able to collect an amount of 175,000.00. Just last year, we again demonstrated our big-heartedness when we collected cash and in kind amounting to more than 800,000.00 pesos as our contribution to the rebuilding and recovery of those affected by Typhoon Ulysses in Cagayan Valley, Region 2.
- 3. In this context, we would once again like to make an appeal to our innate magnanimity and benevolence to support the aforesaid Bike for Hope Project in Support to Salaknib tan Namnama project specially that the target beneficiaries are our very own learners from Benguet. We may give support by either participating in the activity or providing assistance in cash or in kind. Registration fee for the event is 500.00 pesos. For those who wish to offer assistance in cash or kind, these will be submitted to your respective PSDSes or District Coordinating Principals. For the division office, assistance from the OSDS, CID and SGOD will be submitted to Ms. Susan Dawang, Ms. Rizalyn Guznian and Mr. Lucio Alawas, respectively. All collections will be submitted to Ms. Joyce Gavino of the Cashiering Section on our before May 7, 2021.

The race will start at exactly 8AM. It will be MASS START per category with the following START TIME for each category:

12 y/o and below = 8:00AM; ---

Female RB Open Category = 8:06AM; 60 y/o and above = 8:09AM;

50 - 59 y/o = 8:12AM;

30 - 39 y/o = 8:18AM;

13 - 17 y/o = 8:15AM; &

Female MTB Open Category = 8:03AM;

0.40 - 49 y/o = 8:15AM;

18 - 29 y/o = 8:21AM;

Male RB Open Category = 8:18AM.

**NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION. Awarding will immediately follow after the last rider has arrived.

RACE PROTOCOLS:

- 1. All participants are required to observe health protocols (mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing, etc.) at all times, especially before and after the race as riders may opt not to wear face masks while racing.
- 2. Be a smart, courteous and defensive rider. Don't counter flow, follow traffic rules (keep right) always.
- 3. Observe honesty at all times, Outside helps like pushing or towing are not allowed.
