






- To cover camp accommodation (use of camping grounds, light, water & other facilities), program materials, camp souvenirs, badges, certificates, administrative and other camp incidental expenses.

Participants: As many as are interested. However, a minimum of 6-8 girls (1 patrol) Junior GS/Senior GS, Cadet GS per troop and two (2) adult leaders.

Qualifications of Participants:

For Girls:

- 1. Must be currently a registered Junior/Senior/Cadet Girl Scout as of February 8, 2025.
- 2. Must be emotionally stable, physically fit, and alert.
- 3. Must have attended a troop /patrol/district camp.

- For Adults: 1. Must be currently a registered troop leader/adult leader as of February 8, 2025.
 - Must have directed or served as staff in a troop/school/district camp.
 - 3. Must be emotionally stable, physically fit & alert.

- GS Official Uniform: Skirt & blouse with a black belt, scarf, cap, black closed shoes.
- GS Camp Uniform: GS logo shirt, jogging pants, denim pants (ripped or tattered jeans not allowed), sneakers/rubber shoes, slippers
- Personal effects and toiletries, extra shirts/fun-t-shirts, back pack
- Sleeping garments, bedroll/sleeping bag, blanket
- Flashlight, sit-upon (plastic sheet), raincoat
- Set of eating utensils, lunch box, drinking containers
- Writing/Art materials
- Prescribed medicines
- Costume for campfire " A Touch of Red "

For Patrols:

- Tent for shelter (preferably dome tent), Fly tent for kitchen, plastic sheets, laminated sacks
- cooking utensils and stove, firewood
- bamboos for camp gadgets such as an eating table, tripod, clothes lines, etc.
- drum, pails, basins, water dipper (tabo) and other water containers
- rope, bolo, knife, digging materials
- litter or garbage bags, sacks for latrine/bathroom
- food provision for the whole duration of the camp
- costumes for patrol/troop presentation

- Please prepare/rehearse your patrol song, yell, cheer and creative presentation
- Please submit your accomplished camp registration form on or before February 5, 2025 to confirm your participation.
- Please fill up the attached required camp forms.



- Alternate Uniform: Black Polo Shirt /Green and White Combi Shirt and GS green pants
