



**1. What is PYC 2025?**

The Philippine Youth Convention 2025 (PYC 2025), titled *“2030 IS NOW: The 1st Philippine Youth Convention on SDG Localization”*, is a national multi-sectoral convergence organized by the United Nations Association of the Philippines (UNAP) and the United Nations Youth Association of the Philippines (UNYAP). It will gather 1,000+ youth leaders from all 18 regions to advance youth-led actions for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The convention features keynote sessions, plenary discussions, networking opportunities, the **2030 NOW: Youth SDG Impact Awards**, and the election of UNYAP’s national officers—turning global goals into local actions for 2030 and beyond.

**2. When and where will PYC 2025 take place?**

It will be held on **September 21–22, 2025** at the **Legazpi City Convention Center, Legazpi City, Albay**.

**3. Who can participate?**

The convention is open to individual youth, student leaders, organizations, councils, and institutions nationwide, whether or not they are part of the awards program.

**4. How much is the registration fee and what does it include?**

The fee is **₱3,000.00** per participant, **inclusive** of the following:

- Meals (AM snacks, lunch, PM snacks for 2 days, and dinner on Day 1)
- Official convention kit (large tote bag, lanyard & ID, UNYAP pin, official t-shirt)
- Membership & commendation certificates (2 each)

**5. Is there a limit on the number of participants per organization?**

No strict limit. However, **early registration is highly encouraged** to secure slots.

**6. When is the registration deadline?**

The deadline is **September 15, 2025, 11:59 PM** via this Registration Link: [bit.ly/PYC2025RegistrationForm](https://bit.ly/PYC2025RegistrationForm)

**7. Will walk-in registrants be entertained?**

Yes, but only if they pre-registered using this link: [bit.ly/PYC2025WalkIns](https://bit.ly/PYC2025WalkIns).

**8. Can one receipt cover multiple participants?**

Yes. A group can pay in one transaction. However, each participant must still register individually and attach the shared receipt for proper tracking.

**9. How should participants process their payments?**

**10. Will official receipts be issued for liquidation?**

Yes. A physical Official Receipt will be issued during the convention upon request.

**11. What are the highlights of PYC 2026?**

Key highlights include:

- **Official Membership Conferment & Pinning Ceremony**
- **2030 NOW: Youth SDG Impact Awards** honoring youth SDG champions
- **Election of UNYAP Officers** (Luzon, NCR, Visayas, Mindanao, Global, and the National)

**12. Can someone attend in place of a registered participant?**

Yes. Proxies are allowed. If no proxy is sent, the registration fee is non-refundable.

**13. What is the dress code?**

- **Day 1 (Convention):** Business Attire
- **Day 1 (Awards Night):** Barong/Filipiniana (*optional*)
- **Day 2:** Official convention shirt (provided at registration)

**14. Will organizers provide excuse letters for school/work?**

Yes. Excuse letters will be issued upon request through a Google Form.

**15. Will accommodations be provided?**

No. Participants must arrange their own lodging. Booking in advance is strongly advised.

**16. Will transportation be provided?**

No. Transportation is the responsibility of participants. Plan ahead for a smooth trip.
