



- 1. Relative to the conduct of the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) in March 2025, this Office announces the conduct of the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) on January 29-31, 2025, at Tublay School of Home Industries (TSHI), Tublay, Benguet with the theme "Promoting Digital Literacy through Responsible Campus Journalism". (See Enclosure No. 1 for the complete training matrix.)
- 2. The schools will conduct their School Press Conference, followed by the District Schools Press Conference, and the district results shall be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Division before January 29, 2025. The individual, group, and school paper contest criteria are attached in Regional Memorandum No. 180, s. 2024. (See Enclosure 2 for the complete list of individual, group, and school paper contests.)
- 3. Sixteen delegations will participate including the 14 SDO Benguet districts, Benguet State University, and the Benguet Private Schools Association. The first to third placers in the individual events and first placers in the group events in the districts of Atok, Bakun, Bokod, Itogon 1, Itogon 2, Kabayan, Kapangan, Kibungan, Sablan, and Tublay including Benguet Private Schools Association; first to fifth placers in the individual events and first and second placers in the group events in the districts of Buguias, La Trinidad, Mankayan, and Tuba; and first placers in the individual and group events in Benguet State University shall represent their respective delegations during the Division Schools Press Conference.
- 4. Participants shall be billeted in TSHI, Paoad Elementary School, and Tacdian Elementary School.

- 5. For the school paper contests, entries to be submitted will be 10 hard copies printed on long bond papers, with colored pages from front to back.
- 6. Qualified elementary and secondary school paper advisers and campus journalists interested in joining the Search for Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Outstanding Campus Journalists may submit their portfolios to the CID on or before January 28, 2025. (See Enclosure No. 3 for the complete criteria.)
- 7. The Division shall implement the "No School Paper, No Contestant" policy. Only learners from schools with school papers in English and/or Filipino can compete in the various individual and group contests.
- 8. A registration fee of 300 pesos per participant will be collected for the professional fees of speakers and judges, conference materials, certificates, and other incidental expenses. Also, school paper advisers shall pay 60 pesos for their annual dues, while campus journalists pay 30 pesos as membership fees.
- 9. Working committee chairs and members, including proctors, are assigned to ensure the successful conduct of the DSPC. (See Enclosure No. 4 for the list.)
- 10. The participants' food, transportation, and registration fees shall be charged to the schools' MOOE or local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing.
- 11. This memorandum shall serve as an authority to travel on official business for the participants.


