

**CONDUCT OF LEARNER GOVERNMENT (LG) ELECTIONS
 FOR SCHOOL YEAR (S.Y.) 2026-2027**

1. In reference to DM-OUOPS-2026-10-07908 titled Learner Government (LG) Elections for School Year (S.Y.) 2026–2027 and Regional Memorandum No. 046, s. 2026 titled Conduct of Learner Government Elections for School Year 2026-2027, this office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Youth Formation Section, announces the conduct of the Learner Government (LG) Elections for S.Y. 2026–2027. The establishment of Learner Government in all elementary and secondary schools provides learners with opportunities to assume leadership roles and highlights the significance of learner-led clubs and organizations in amplifying learners’ voices in decision-making, thereby contributing to their holistic growth and development.

2. The election shall be conducted following the schedule outlined below:

School-Based Elections	January 26-30; February 2-13, 2026
District Elections	February 16-18, 2026
Deadline of Submission of District Election Results	February 19, 2026
Division Elections (via MS Teams) Meeting Link:	February 20, 2026 9:00 AM onwards https://acesse.one/DPLGElections2026-27

3. The school’s Commission on Elections and Appointments (COMEAs) shall oversee the elections of other recognized clubs and organizations.

4. School based elections of the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O), Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD), and other student-led organizations shall commence after the election of SELG/SSLG officers. In addition, YES-O, BKD, and other student-led organizations may also use the guidelines of the Learner Government in conducting their elections.

5. For the District level Learner Government Elections, 1 district representative and 1 alternate representative shall be elected.

All District Youth Formation Coordinators shall be in-charge of the conduct of the district elections and are advised to submit the names of their newly elected District SELG/SSLG Representatives to the Division Youth Formation Coordinators through sdobenguet.yfd@deped.gov.ph on or before **February 19, 2026**.
7. Pending the approval of the revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Learner Government Program (LGP), schools are advised to refer to the previously issued guidelines which may be accessed via: <https://tinyurl.com/LGP2026-2027>.
8. Implementing schools are required to adhere to the prescribed guidelines but are encouraged to revise or enhance them through a formal resolution, to align with the school's specific context and needs.
