



- 1) In reference to Division Memorandum No. 301, s. 2025, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), through the BSP Benguet Council, in partnership with the Schools Division of Benguet, will conduct the 52<sup>nd</sup> Council Scout Jamboree. Originally scheduled for November 14–16, 2025, the activity will now be held on February 6–8, 2026, at Kamora National High School, Gusaran, Kabayan, Benguet.

- 6) School personnel participating in the activities are entitled to claim Vacation Service Credits/Compensatory time off provided that the required documents are accomplished and submitted within one (1) month after the completion of the activity as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024.
- 7) This memorandum shall serve as the travel authority on official business for all identified participants.

With the theme: "Scouts in harmony with nature" aims to develop scouts as Messenger of Peace and awareness on global issues affecting the environment. Scouts will deepen their understanding about peace and environment in the local community and in the society in general.

#### 1. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

Camp fee – seven hundred pesos (Php700.00) shall be collected per participant to cover the following:

- Souvenir items, Identification card, advancement completion cards; Patch, stickers advancement cards and activity materials, ingredients and other supplies per module activity
- Hands-on tote bag printing using official Council Jamborette Pictagram
- Administration, program and technical preparations
- Camp management & other administration

#### 2. Special Activities – Participation Guidelines

**2.1. Camp Development Projects** – Despite of the advent of information communication technology, modern gadgets, tools and equipment scouting remain well verse in pioneering and camp craft gadgets, participating units are expected to display the art and science of skillful living in the outdoors or the art of "back to basic" camp gadgets. There will be selection for the best camp layout and gadgets.

**Delegates shall bring bamboos and other materials for the camp development;**

**Note: delegates shall maximize the spaces in their respective sub camps, space to occupy must be good enough for the number of participants only.**

**2.2. KAB PALABAS** – The KAWAN UNITS of the host Municipality shall prepare any presentation to entertain the participants and other guests right after the opening program however, the activity is open to other scouting districts who would like to organize and participate in the presentation. This is also an opportunity for the KAB scouts to experience a day camp at the Jamboree site. There will be no camp fee for the KAB Scouts of Kabayan who will be rendering entertainment.

**2.3. SCOUTS GO WESTERN**- This comprise of country song and dance presentation through country music duet contest country western line dance for Boy Scout section and Country western dance for the Senior scouts

**Participating school must prepare a D.I.Y costume, props out of recycled materials to enhance the presentation.**

**2.4. Battle of the Bands**- featuring country love songs Senior Scouts and Adult Leaders category

**2.5. LOGO MAKING CONTEST / SOUVENIR ITEM DESIGN** – featuring scouting and nature aim to come up with a design that will be adopted as a token in preparation for the next jamboree. The perspective logo/ design must have a detailed description including the color symbolism. The Design must be drawn in short bond paper with folder, preparation of design ahead of time is allowed ready for submission at the Jamboree Secretariat. Do not write name on the bond paper, the secretariat will be responsible to list names upon submission of entry.

2.6. Jamboree Balita writing contest – This is a contest on news writing, editorial, feature writing, cartooning etc. winning entries will be printed in the official Jamborette newsletter

2.7. Council Youth Forum –The activity will develop youth participation in decision making, Youth engagement and youth empowerment.

- 3.4. GO Explorers Go Adventure - Exploring the different tourism spots of the Municipality with the theme: "Nature and conservation."
- 3.5. Advancement Booth - Scouts will learn community related prevention and awareness including life survival and safety measures. At the end of all the activities the advancement booth will serve as evaluation area and releasing of sticker merit badges as a certification that scouts passed the different module activities.

**4. Grand Opening Ceremonies/ Evening Presentations & sub camp activities**






