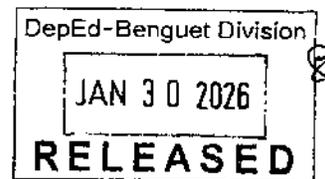

**PROVINCIAL STARS GATHER-IN 2026 & SIMULTANEOUS JUNIOR, SENIOR  
AND CADET GIRL SOUT PROVINCIAL CAMPS**

1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) through the Benguet Girl Scout Council in partnership with SDO-Benguet will be conducting the following activities:

- 1.1 Provincial Stars Gather-In (Grades 1 to 3) on **February 27 to March 1, 2026**, at *Benguet Girl Scout Council Headquarters (Baley Ni Girl Scout), Km. 5, La Trinidad, Benguet.*
- 1.2 Simultaneous Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scout Provincial Camps on **March 13-15, 2026**, at *Lubo Kibungan, Benguet.*

5. School heads of participating teachers shall ensure that their classes are handled during the training dates.

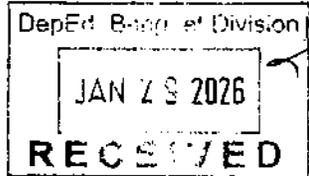

**Fee: Php 700.00/girls and adults**

- For Girls:**
1. Must be currently a registered Junior/Senior/Cadet Girl Scout as of March 7, 2026.
  2. Must be emotionally stable, physically fit, and alert.
  3. Must have attended a patrol /troop/district camp.
- For Adults:**
1. Must be currently a registered troop leader/adult leader as of March 7, 2026.
  2. Must have attended/participated in a troop/school/district camp.
  3. Must be emotionally stable, physically fit & alert.

**GS Official Uniform:**

Junior GS: Green dress, scarf, cap, white socks, black closed shoes

Senior/Cadet GS: Skirt & blouse with a black belt, scarf, cap, black closed shoes.

**GS Camp/Active Uniform:** GS logo shirt, bermuda shorts, socks (white or green), jogging pants

- \* Personal effects and toiletries, extra shirts/fun-t-shirts, back pack
- \* Jogging pants, denim pants (ripped or tattered jeans not allowed in camp)
- \* Rubber shoes/sneakers, slippers
- \* Sleeping wear, bedroll/sleeping bag, blanket
- \* Flashlight, sit-upon (plastic sheet), raincoat, umbrella
- \* Set of eating utensils, lunch box, drinking containers
- \* Writing/Art materials, scissors for cutting fuzzy wires, sewing kit for bracelet-making
- \* Prescribed medicines
- \* Costume for Campfire "Western Wear"

**For Patrols:**

- \* Tent for shelter (preferably dome tent for easy pitching of tents)
- \* Fly tent for kitchen, plastic sheets
- \* cooking utensils and stove, firewood
- \* camp gadgets such as: eating table, tripod, clothes lines, etc.
- \* pails, basins and other water containers (no need to bring drums, water supply is sufficient)
- \* rope, bolo, knife, digging materials
- \* litter or garbage bags, sacks for latrine/bathroom (by school)
- \* food provision for the whole duration of the camp
- \* costumes/attire for patrol/troop presentation

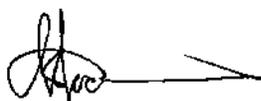
**Friendly Reminders:**

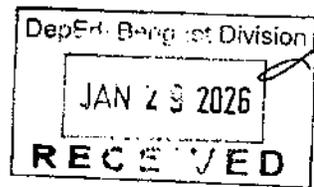
