

### CONDUCT OF THE 2025 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS-TECHNOLYMPICS

- 1. The Schools Division of Benguet shall conduct the 2025 Division Festival of Talents-Technolympics with the theme "Talent Fusion: Where Diversity Meets Excellence for the Bagong Pilipinas" on March 12-14, 2025, at the Kamora National High School, Gusaran, Kabayan.
- The events will provide opportunities for students to showcase their performance in various skills
  acquired in their respective specialization in Edukasyong Pantahanan (EPP), Technology and
  Livelihood Education (TLE) and Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL)- Senior High School
  Track.
- 3. The first-place winners in the District Level-Technolympics shall be the participants to the division level contests.
- 4. List of official participants from each district shall be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Office through EPS Samuel S. Ayangdan on or before March 5, 2024 with the following documentary requirements:
  - a. For Contestants
  - 1) Certification by the School Head that each learner-participant is a duly enrolled pupil/student enrolled in a public or private elementary, general secondary, Special Technical Vocational Program Education (SPTVE) or SUC.
- 2) Certification by the school head that the learner/s is/are enrolled in the field of specialization (secondary) or the pupil/s is/are enrolled in Grade 4, 5 or 6 (elementary)
- h. For Teacher-Coaches, a certification from the School Head that the teacher is a staff of the school heing represented and a written designation as the adviser/coach of the student/pupils represented shall be included.

- 5. As per agreement during the pre-planning meeting conducted on January 22, 2025, a registration fee of P1,350.00 per participants will be collected to cover the expenses for six (6) meals and three (3) snacks, purchase of trophies, certificates, electricity and other operational expenses chargeable against local funds and other available sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. However, participants are given the option to either cook their own meals on-site or have meals catered by private individuals if desired and to pay a registration fee of P300.00 to cover incidental expenses.
- 7. All the Elementary and Secondary District Coordinators shall inform the host school of any district choice regarding meal arrangements and any additional participants who may choose to cook for themselves or make separate catering arrangements.
- 8. Arrival of the participants will be at 1:00 PM of March 12, 2025. First meal will dinner of the same date and last meal will be lunch on March 14, 2025. Upon arrival, participants shall immediately register at the Registration Area. Upon registration, official receipt and meal tickets shall be given to be presented to the billeting in-charge.
- 9. All participants are required to bring their own beddings, sufficient clothing and medicine as needed for the duration of the activity. Participants are expected to bring their contest supplies, materials, tools/equipment, except those that are to be provided by the host school as agreed during the Planning Conference.
- 10. Each district delegation shall bring their banner and uniform.
- 12. All the Offices, School Head Coordinators of District Technolympics, elementary and secondary participants and Contests Administrators are required to attend the solidarity meeting at 2:00 P.M. onward on March 12, 2025, as attendance will be checked.
- 13. Other details, possible changes and concerns shall be shared in the Offical group chat of EPP-TLE Disitrict Coordinators and others shall be discussed during the solidarity meeting.
- 14. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
