Dear Ma'ams and Sirs,

The May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections (2025 NLE) is fast approaching and once again we ask for your usual cooperation in making the electoral exercises fair and meaningful.

Pursuant to RA 9006 or the Fair Elections Act, enunciated for the 2025 NLE in COMELEC Resolution No. 11086, specifically Section 8, paragraphs 1(f) and 2(5) thereof, political posters and campaign materials are prohibited in public places, including government offices and its vicinities.

Accordingly, please do not allow any violations of these provisions within your area of jurisdiction, and instruct your people to take down illegal posters therein, should there be any.

Should we experience undue pressure in performing our duties, let us make our candidates understand that these kinds of violations are offensive to La Trinidad and Benguet voters, and that unlawful campaigning may do more damage than good to their name.
