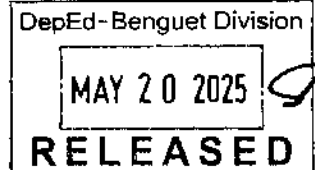

The Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL), an international non-profit, non-governmental organization committed to global peacebuilding efforts, in partnership with the Department of Education – Schools Division of Benguet since 2023, will conduct its annual Peace Education Online Training Program on **May 22-24, 2025, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM via Zoom.**

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HWPL'S ASIA PEACE EDUCATION CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

"Empowering Educators in Spreading the Culture of Peace"



I. RATIONALE:

HWPL, an international non-profit, non-governmental organization registered under the United Nations Global Communications Agency and with special consultative status with the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), has been actively working since its foundation in 2013 for the achievement of world peace and the cessation of war through its three main initiatives: international law, alliance of religions, and peace education.,

HWPL emphasizes the importance of transforming violent culture caused by conflicts into a culture of peace. A "Culture of Peace" is developed in one's behavior and way of life that promotes peaceful living while reflecting and changing past behavior such as violence, conflicts, and wars. Therefore, students should be taught to respect each other's diverse characteristics and to pursue reconciliation and solidarity. Therefore, from the school— which is a miniature version of the world community — students will form the spirit and culture of peace

The program, **HWPL's Peace Educators Training**, themed ***"Empowering Educators in Spreading the Culture of Peace,"*** is objectively designed to effectively address the challenges faced by education institutions in the implementation and/or integration of Peace Education in the curriculum, foremost among which are:

1. Unavailability of sample curriculum on Peace Education
2. Scarcity of available learning materials on Peace Education
3. Costly and inadequate training for Peace Educators

The **Peace Education Program of HWPL** ensures that the youth acquire knowledge and skills needed for the promotion of a culture of peace and non-violence. HWPL has cooperated with various schools and education institutions worldwide to promote skills of peacemaking in their homes, schools, community, the nation, and the world.

II. OBJECTIVES

The Peace Educators Training offered by HWPL aims to:

1. Promote responsive awareness of HWPL's Peace Education Operations and Initiatives among the administrators, faculty, staff, and students of private and public education institutions in the all Regions nationwide.
2. Provide a venue for the opportune recall and prompt realization of binding directives pertinent to Peace Education (CHED CMO No.42 s2021 dated 31 December 2021, CHED CMO No.01 s2019 dated 2 April 2019 and DepEd DO No.32 s2019 dated 11 November 2019).
3. Present HWPL's Peace Education Instructional Program and Materials for recommended use of Peace Education Teachers
4. Prepare Peace Education Teachers in the efficient and effective conduct of Peace Education Class-time proceedings.
5. Propagate the spread of the culture of peace among students to become peace makers at home, peace messengers in the community, peace educators in the nation and peace ambassadors in the world through the corporate efforts of the school and their Peace Education Teachers.

REQUIREMENTS

1. **Enlistment of Peace Education Coordinators**

Each school should appoint one Peace Education Coordinator. The roles or responsibilities of the coordinators are as follows:

- Receive all the invitations to the events from HWPL and cascade to the President and peace teachers.
- Receive the instructional materials and ensures that these are all distributed to the appointed teachers.
- Direct communication with HWPL with the plans including execution and monitoring of program and project proposals.
- Gather the peace education teachers report in teaching peace education to their classes
