

**ENDORSEMENT OF VISUAL INSPECTION WITH ACETIC ACID (VIA) AND
 CLINICAL BREAST EXAMINATION (CBE) FOR SCHOOL PERSONNEL**

To: Schools District Supervisors, Coordinating Principals
 Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
 School/District Nurses Concerned
 School Health and Nutrition Unit Personnel

1. In our continuous efforts to promote the health and well-being of school personnel, the Schools Division of Benguet, in partnership with the Tublay Rural Health Unit, endorses the conduct of Visual Inspection with Acetic Acid (VIA) and Clinical Breast Examination (CBE) services in selected schools.
2. These vital health screenings are aimed at the early detection and prevention of cervical and breast cancer and will be administered by trained health professionals. All procedures shall strictly observe health and safety protocols as mandated by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Department of Education (DepEd).
3. This initiative specifically targets **female school personnel aged 30 to 65 years old and sexually active**, in accordance with DOH-recommended guidelines for early cancer detection.
4. Concerned school heads are enjoined to provide their full support and assistance for the smooth conduct of these activities in their respective schools.






