IMPLEMENTATION OF PEACE EDUCATION ADVOCACY IN ALL SCHOOLS

TO: Chief Education Supervisors, CID, and SGOD
PSDSs/PSDIs
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
School Stakeholders and All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to the partnership between the Department of Education – Benguet Division and Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL) Philippines, formalized through a Memorandum of Agreement in 2024, this Office directs the full implementation of the HWPL Peace Education Program in all public elementary and secondary schools across the Division.

2. In view of the recently conducted HWPL Asia Peace Educators Training 2025 last May 22–24, 2025, and in line with the Department's advocacy to promote peace, harmony, tolerance, and mutual respect, all schools are instructed to comply with the following:

a. Designation of Peace Education Focal Person

Every school shall designate one (1) Peace Education Focal Person who will coordinate school-level implementation and liaise with the Division SMN Section and HWPL partners.

b. Submission through the Official Registration Link

School Heads shall register their schools and their Peace Education Focal Person via this link:

The deadline for registration is July 15, 2025.

This is in preparation for the Memorandum of Understanding for all schools across the Benguet Division with HWPL.

c. Use of HWPL Peace Education Instructional Program and Materials

HWPL has provided an official set of instructional materials and learning modules for peace education. These will be used during National Learning Camps, school break activities, and other relevant peace-building learning platforms. **Refer to Attachments 1 through 7.**

d. Engagement in Peace Education Activities

All schools are enjoined to actively participate in HWPL-led and DepEd-partnered peace initiatives such as Peace Lecture Series, Peace Camps, and Inter-School Dialogues. Additional guidance and schedules will be provided by the SMN Section.

e. Community Collaboration for Peacebuilding



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Schools must initiate community-based activities in collaboration with Local Government Units (LGUs), Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs), PNP, Government line agencies, and civic organizations. Recommended activities include Peace Walks, Community Dialogues, and localized peace workshops.

3. In view of the continuing efforts to institutionalize Peace Education across all public elementary and secondary schools in the Division of Benguet in partnership with the Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL) Philippines, this Office hereby constitutes the Schools Division Technical Working Group (TWG) for Peace Education to ensure efficient planning, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of peace education initiatives in alignment with DepEd goals. **See Annex 1.**
4. The Social Mobilization and Networking (SMN) Section, in coordination with other functional divisions, shall provide technical assistance, conduct monitoring, and ensure that peace education is effectively integrated and sustained across all schools.

6. All concerned personnel are enjoined to actively participate and extend their support in promoting peace education in their respective areas of assignment.
