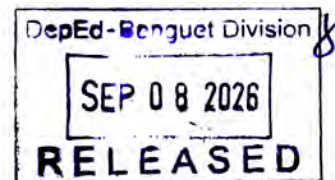

**DISSEMINATION OF DEPED MEMORANDUM 90, S.2026 TITLED DISSEMINATION OF THE  
REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10627,  
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANTI-BULLYING ACT OF 2013**

PSDSs/PSDIs  
Public and Private Schools

1. This Memorandum is issued to disseminate DepEd Memorandum No. 90, s. 2025, or the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 10627, otherwise known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013.
2. This Memorandum repeals DepEd Memorandum No. 55, s. 2013, titled "Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10627, Otherwise Known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013."
3. As stated in Section 5 of the revised IRR, this Office emphasizes that **all public basic education schools and Community Learning Centers (CLCs) shall adopt and operationalize the standard anti-bullying policies to be cascaded by the DepEd Central Office, as provided in Annex D of DO No. 6, s. 2026. Private basic education schools** are likewise required to adopt and operationalize anti-bullying policies that shall, at a minimum, align with the standard policy issued by the DepEd Central Office.
4. To further strengthen the role of learners and parents or parent-substitutes, this Office encourages public and private basic education schools and CLCs to include in their student handbooks a Student and Parent/Parent Substitute Acknowledgment and Commitment section wherein they agree to abide by the school's rules and regulations and affirm their respective roles in the prevention of bullying.
