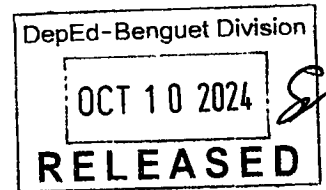

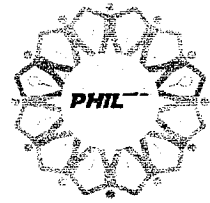

Update Coaches, Teachers, Parents thru Coaches Workshop

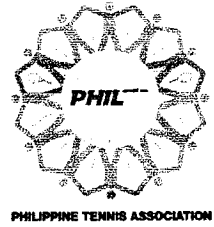
Highlights
