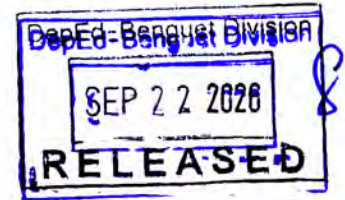

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF FO GUANG SHAN FOUNDATION INC.- THREE

1. This is to announce the **List of Recipient Schools for the Fo Guang Shan Foundation Inc. – Three Acts of Goodness (TAG) Project Cycle 11** for School Year 2026–2027. The recipient schools were selected by the FGS based on the goals and objectives of the TAG Program.
2. The list of recipient schools, project titles, school heads, and TAG project proponents is attached to this memorandum.
3. The TAG Projects aim to help learners grow into well-rounded and responsible Filipino youth. These school-based projects promote good deeds, kind words, and positive thoughts to build character and improve well-being.
4. Each approved TAG project will receive a **Php 10,000 cash grant**, which will be transferred to the school's account in **October 2026**. Project implementation shall run from **October 2026** to **March 2027**.
5. The Awarding Ceremony shall be held on **October 23-24, 2026**, at **Fo Guang Shan Mabuhay Temple, 656 P. Ocampo St., Malate, Manila**. Selected participants identified by FGS shall arrive on **October 22, 2026**, to participate in an immersion program.
6. The details of the Awarding Ceremony and the list of identified participants are attached to this Memorandum. This Memorandum shall also serve as their Authority to Travel.

7. Participants who render service beyond regular workdays may be granted the applicable service credits or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), subject to existing DepEd policies, rules, and regulations.
8. A travel sponsorship of **Php 2,000** shall be provided to each participant traveling to the venue. Accommodation and meals for the duration of the activity shall be sponsored by the FGS, Inc. Other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Recipient schools shall prepare their **Work and Financial Plan (WFP)** and **School Operating Budget (SOB)** and submit the same to the School Division Office (SDO) **on or before October 30, 2026**.
