

2024 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS PHASE 2 IN SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED)/SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION (SNED)

TO: CID and SGOD Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors/Public Schools District In-charge
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

- 1. Relative to the celebration of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities in the Philippines every December 3 of the year and pursuant to Presidential Proclamation 1157 s. 2006 and Republic Act 7277-"Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities" which guarantees the rights of persons with disabilities, including their rights to access quality education and participate in cultural and recreational activities, the Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the Division Festival of Talents Phase 2 in Special Education/Special Needs Education on December 6, 2024 at SDO Benguet Adivay Hall, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. showcase skills and talents of learners in Special Education (SPED) or Special Needs Education SNED) program;
 - b. raise awareness about the needs, talents, and potentials of SPED/SNED learners within the school, district and division; and
 - c. strengthen the partnership between school staff, students, and families, creating a more inclusive environment.
- 3. All elementary and secondary schools implementing SPED/SNED program or with learners with disabilities (LWDs) shall conduct school level activities related to the celebration of international recognition of people with disabilities by discovering, developing and show casing their talents.
- 4. First placers in the schools shall participate in the district-level activities. Similarly, the first-place winners in the events under the different categories in the district shall qualify for the 2024 Division Festival of Talents-Phase 2 in SPED/SNED.

- 5. The expected number of participants per district to the division festival of Talents is in **enclosure 1** and the mechanics and criteria for the contest events are in **enclosure 2**. The Technical Working Group (TWG) for the activity is listed in **enclosure 3**.
- 6. Meals and snacks of the technical working group during the division level activities shall be charged against the 2024 Provincial Special Education Fund while travel and incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. This memorandum shall also serve as Authority to Travel on official business for all listed participants.

CRITERIA/ MECHANICS OF CONTEST ACTVITIES

I. Mechanics

- 1. Contestants are currently enrolled in public schools and SPED Centers for SY 2024 2025 and tagged in the Learners' Information System (LIS) as children with disability. If the learners are not tagged in the LIS, an assessment record from the psychometrician or medical practitioners may suffice.
 - a. A contestant is allowed to participate in ONE category or event only.
 - b. The story or selection to be read through braille reading by learner who is visually impaired and in Filipino sign language by a hearing impaired learner will be provided by the contest administrators during the contest proper.
 - c. The contest piece for solo singing for both elementary and secondary level is "Ako'y Pinoy" by Florante. It will be sung by the contestant in acappella but with microphone.
 - d. For the dance contest both music and dance steps of the "Girl in the Mirror Zumba Dance for Kids" will be used for the elementary and secondary level. Two participants or a pair of learners with common or different disabilities could participate in this event.
- e. The theme for this year's National Festival of Talents -"Pagkakaisa't Pagkakabuklod Tungo sa Matatag, Maginhawa, Panatag at Makabatang Bansa" will be used as theme for draw and tell for elementary level and for poster making for the secondary level. They will be given one hour and thirty minutes for the drawing activity and three (3) to five (5) minutes to talk about in their output specifically for draw and tell.
- f. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
- g. Winners per category will be identified by the Board of Judges.
- h. First to third placers learner-winners will receive cash incentives from the Provincial Special Education Fund (SEF) and Certificate of Recognition together with their coaches while Certificate of participation to the other participants.


