



DIVISION SPORTS TRAINING OF COACHES

- 1. In support to the Department of Education's thrust of improving the implementation of school sports, DepEd-Benguet shall conduct a Division Sports Training of Coaches on November 21 to 23, 2024 in all the sports events that will be played in the upcoming Provincial Athletic Meet except lawn tennis and wushu (lawn tennis was conducted last October 19 & 20, 2024 and wushu has no available trainers as of the moment). Combative sports including gymnastics will continue via online apps on November 24 and 30, 2024 to comply with the required 40 number of hours.
- 2. Participants are the district winning coaches that have not completed the required number of hours of trainings to coach (IRR of RA 10588, 24 hours for non-combative sports and 40 hours for combative). Other interested future coaches may participate if they are permitted by their school heads.
- The SEF budget for this training is good for 150 participants. The distribution are as 3. follows: 72 management, trainer/speakers, secretariat and 6 participants per district. District heads are requested to submit immediately the names of the six participants from their district via group chat "SDO-Benguet Sports Coordinators".
- Trainers are the tournament directors. Tournament directors who are going to the 4. Batang Pinov must designate an alternate trainer. Trainers are responsible to prepare the needed equipment and training matrix.
- 5. Participants must be physically fit, with proper sports attires and shall bring along with them sports equipment to use during the training.
- Teacher participants must prepare learning activities and resources for their classes in 6. advance to be managed by their school heads during their absence.

- 7. Lunch and snacks for the official participants identified above shall be provided. Other expenses relative to their participation to this training shall be charged to local funds subject to the accounting rules and regulations.
- 8. One day service credits/compensatory overtime credits shall be given to regular DepEd employees for the training services/attendance on November 23, 2024, except the above identified funded participants.
- 9. This memorandum shall serve as authority to travel, on official business of all the participants. Likewise, this will serve as a notice to the concerned school heads identified as training venues to kindly make their facilities available.
