

## STAGING OF THE BENGUET PROVINCIAL ATHLETIC MEET FOR SY 2024-2025

- 1. Republic Act 10588 or otherwise known as the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013 mandates the conduct of sports development and competitions in the Palarong Pambansa, and to be adopted in the regions, divisions, and schools. Also, Article XIV, Section 19 of the Constitution states that "the state shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international sports, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert society".
- 2. Consistent with the above provision, DepEd-Benguet and the Provincial Government of Benguet will conduct the Staging of the Benguet Provincial Athletic Meet for SY 2024-2025 on December 3 to 7, 2024, with the Theme: "Empowering Future Champions" at the Benguet Sports Complex, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the first-place winners of the various sports events competed in the district selection meets.

- 5. Demo sports are futsal elementary girls and Muay Thai elementary boys, girls and secondary boys and girls. Medals earned in these events are counted in the regular medal tally. Para Games have separate medal tally.
- 6. Billeting quarters of the delegations are distributed and apportioned per capacity of the host school. See *enclosure*.
- 7. Tournament directors are the lead persons in the preparation of playing venues and borrowing of needed equipment. See enclosure.
- 8. Tournament directors and winning coaches shall submit the list of winners (winner takes all in team events), including the record of time/performance in measured sports (swimming, archery, and athletics). They shall also submit the uniform sizes of all first-place winners of athletes, coaches, chaperons and trainers.
- 9. Classes are not suspended. However, DepEd personnel who are utilized to work as technical officials, coaches, trainers, chaperons, members of the technical working groups shall

arrange their workload with their school head to ensure continuity of learnings while they are in the meet.

- 10. Each delegation shall bring along with them their delegation flags for hoisting during the opening program.
- 11. Plastic bottles will not be allowed and the use of woods for cooking is prohibited in all billeting schools.
- 12. Group insurance is highly recommended to all athletes. Expenses for water consumption by the delegations in the billeting area shall be shouldered by them, while electric consumption shall be charged to the MOOE of the host school.
- 12. In the promotion of sports, and, recognizing the sacrifices and hard efforts of the athletes competing in their chosen event representing their school barangay and municipality; schools are asked to be considerate in addressing the needs of athletes on the classes they missed; so that, no athlete will receive a **decreased grade** due to their participation to sports activities. Remediation/make-up activities and other alternative modes shall be done to address their needs.
