

**EMPOWERING NON-MAPEH MAJORS/SPECIALIZATION: FOUNDATIONAL TRAINING ON THE BASICS OF MAPEH ALIGNED WITH THE MATATAG CURRICULUM**

1. The Schools Division of Benguet, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will conduct a Training-Workshop on “Empowering Non-MAPEH Majors: Foundational Training on the Basics of MAPEH Aligned with the MATATAG Curriculum” for newly hired Non-MAPEH Majors/Specialization teachers on November 4–7, 2025, at Asin Hot Spring Pooten Resort, Asin Road, Tuba, Benguet.
2. This training aims to address the challenges faced by newly hired Non-MAPEH Majors/Specialized teachers by equipping them with essential knowledge, effective teaching strategies, and digital tools necessary to deliver quality instruction. The integration of technology and educational applications across MAPEH components is expected to enhance classroom engagement and support diverse learners in today’s digital learning environment.
3. The participants of this training are the 62 identified teachers from selected schools, along with 12 resource persons, facilitators, and members of the Program Management Team from partner institutions and SDO-Benguet.
4. Participants who wish to join the shuttle service are advised to assemble in front of the SDO-Benguet Office on or before 6:45 a.m. on November 4, 2025. Departure will be at exactly 7:00 a.m. Those who will travel on their own or commute must be at the venue by 8:00 a.m. The Opening Program will start promptly at 8:30 a.m.
